## WHAT IS OMBROPHOBLA?

There are a lot of interesting phobias in the world. One of them Ombrophobia, also known as Pluviophobia. Ombrophobia is the fear of rain. It is seen in children and teenagers more than adults. People who have this phobia be afraid of the outdoors during rainy days. Some of the sufferers might fear very heavy rain that accompanies storm-like conditions (heavy winds, thunder, and lightning), still, others might be afraid of even a little light rain.

Ombrophobia has different symptoms in children and adults. Some of the symptoms that are seen in children are shaking uncontrollably and begging to be taken home, screaming and crying loudy or asking questions like "will we get flooded or ?" Adults with this phobia might have an elevated heartbeat, or they might display heightened anxiety or have a full-blown panic attack. Also, they look at the sky and weather forecast constantly to monitor rains.

Childhood memories can be the reason for Ombrophobia. For example, people might be afraid of the rain because of an accident that happened in the past, due to rain. Also, burns and wounds that extreme acid rain causes on human skin can also cause this phobia. It is usually treated with therapy to overcome this phobia.

### ARACHIBUTYROPHOBIA

There are about 400 types of phobias that have entered the literature around the world. Some of these are interesting enough to amaze you when you see them.

The phobia I'll mention is Arachibutyrophobia, fear of peanut butter. This is actually not the fear of peanut butter as an object, it's a fear of the situation of having it stick to the roof of your mouth. When children have simple phobias, they may not be able to express how they are feeling. Instead, they may react by crying or having a tantrum. Common physical symptoms of this panic include chest tightness or difficulty breathing, dizziness or feeling like you're going to pass out, rapid heart rate or heart palpitations, tremors, or sweating. Dread or worry about having to eat peanut butter, inability to control or overcome the fear of peanut butter, intense panic or fear while eating peanut butter, and strong desire to avoid peanut butter are also symptoms of Arachibutyrophobia.

Peanut butter is not a substance found in every nutrient, such as water. And even if we don't eat peanut butter, we can afford the basics we need to get from other foods. In other words, not eating peanut butter and keeping it out of sight as much as possible is the solution to Arachibutyrophobia.






To make this pencil holder you need felt, a ruler, a pencil, a scissors, a needle and some thread. First, draw two rectangles on the felt as you can see in the photo. Then, cut the rectangles with scissors.



Put the small rectangle on the big rectangle and sew it in the middle. After that, stitch both sides and bottom of the pencil holder.





Cut a rubber into the pencil holder according to the size of the notebook/book on which you will attach it. Stitch from the end of the rubber you cut as in the picture.




Glue the rubber to pencil holder so that you can attach it to your notebook/book. Stick a small piece of felt to the place where you stitch so that it does not look bad.

#### **PANORAMA 1453 HISTORY MUSEUM**

One of my favorite places is the Panorama 1453 History Museum in Turkey. The museum is located in Istanbul-Topkapı. This is a panoramic museum where the conquest of Istanbul by Fatih Sultan Mehmet, the sounds of cannons in a room, the neighing of the Ottoman horses, and the Mehter Team are given as effects. The museum was opened on January 31, 2009. It also has the distinction of being the world's first panoramic museum.

I think this museum is very interesting. Because the painting works here are spread over an area of 360 degrees and placed top-down and right-left. So whichever direction you look at, you can see a part of the picture. The picture is unframed. A 360-degree view was created in an area of 3000 square meters, without its borders.

When you look at this image, you will feel three dimensions and when you visit this place, you may have special money that you can keep as a souvenir. You can also buy some souvenirs from this museum.

I went there when I was seven years old and when I got inside, I thought that everything was real. There were soldiers, horses, cannonballs, cannons, and swords. They were so realistic. When you enter the museum, you will feel as if you are watching the war.

## **GLOBAL WARMING**

The greenhouse gases that are formed by the increase of heat-holding gases such as carbon dioxide in the atmosphere and released into the atmosphere cause an event called the greenhouse effect. As a result of the greenhouse effect, there is an increase in the average temperatures measured on land, sea, and air throughout the year. These increases in average temperatures are called global warming.

The increase in the average temperature of the earth measured in the last two decades is 0.25 - 0.4 C degrees. According to the research of scientists, it is estimated that the effects of global warming will reach incredible dimensions in the next hundred years and cause an increase of 1.4 to 5.8 C degrees in the world average temperature.

The causes of global warming are determined in two ways. One of them is natural causes and the other is artificial reasons. Natural causes include changes in the ozone layer due to harmful rays from the sun. The artificial cause is the greenhouse effect. Greenhouse gas is such an important condition that it can cause droughts and floods. The increase in the rate of carbon dioxide in the air due to the gases coming out of the chimneys of the factories and the destruction of the forests by the people causes the increase of greenhouse gases. In addition, the gasses we use such as deodorants and perfumes, and the exhaust gases emitted by cars also cause a greenhouse effect. 31

Global warming brings many problems with it. Problems caused by global warming include melting glaciers, rising seawater levels, and some natural disasters. There is a serious decrease in the number of animals and plants that cannot withstand the effects of seasonal changes. Furthermore, it has direct effects on human health. Climate changes cause various diseases such as respiratory system diseases, cardiovascular system diseases, and allergic diseases. All of these cause imbalances in nature.

In order to leave a more livable world to future generations, we should use the world we live in more correctly and use public transportation as much as possible. At the same time, we should keep the environment clean and consume as much as necessary and reduce the use of drugs in agriculture and animal husbandry to prevent global warming. If we strive for all these, we can contribute to preventing global warming.

### SEYIT CORPORAL

Seyit Corporal was born in the Havran District Çamlık (Manastır) village in September 1889. His full name is Seyit Ali Çabuk. His father was Abdurrahman and his mother was Emine. Seyit was enlisted in early April 1909. He participated in the Balkan Wars in 1912. After the war, he was not demobilized and served as an artillery soldier in the Dardanelles Front.

On March 18,1915, the Allied navy attacked to cross the Dardanelles. Meanwhile, Seyit Corporal was in charge of the Rumeli Mecidiye Bastion. The intense counter fire of the Turkish artillery and the mines that the mine ship Nusret previously dropped repelled this attack. Due to the shots made, the crane of the cannon, which was in the bastion, was destroyed.

Sevit Corporal lifted the 215 Okkalık bullet three times with great force and drove it to the end of the barrel and with this heroism, the Ocean ship was badly wounded. Sevit Corporal returned to his village in the autumn of 1918. He continued his own profession, forestry and coaling. He received the surname 'Çabuk' with the surname law enacted in 1934. He passed away in 1939 due to a lung disease.

Barış Manço was born on January 2, 1943. He became interested in music at the age of his secondary school education. His high school years started at Galatasaray High School.



In 1966, he released two 45's records in Paris. When he returned to Turkey in 1970, he founded the group "Kaygısızlar" with Fuat Güner and Mazhar Alanson.He worked with the Mongols in 1971. In the same year, he founded Kurtalan Ekspres. He shot his first music video for "Hey Koca Topçu" in 1973. He made his first album "2023" in 1975.

He married Lale Manço in 1978 and had two sons, Doğukan and Batıkan. Barış Manço died on the night of January 31, 1999.

The Beatles was founded in the United Kingdom in 1960. Its members are John Lennon, Paul McCartney, George Harrison and Ringo Starr. The Beatles, which have built a huge reputation, are known as one of the best bands in the history of music. Although they mostly make rock music, they also have country and blues songs. There are 14 studio albums.

First, we got on the boats then coast guard took us to airport. There were a lot of journalists at the airport. They wanted to speak with us but I wasn't ready to talk to anyone about the accident. So, we left from there without talking to anyone.

Authorized people gave dry and clear clothes to us. We wore them and we took a taxi to go home with my brother. I don't think I will take a plane for a long time.

Our health is fine. We were lucky to travel with pilot Sully. I think he is the best pilot in the world because I could be in a hospital or in a grave right now.



# Coffee Parfait

After preparing the egg mixture, let it cool in a separate bowl and add the biscuits and nuts. Then add the whipped cream and milk coffee you have kept in the fridge and continue mixing. Cover the inside of the piece muffin molds with cling film. Divide the mixture you have prepared into molds and let it rest for 3 hours in the deep freezer after stretching. Enjoy your meal!






