# UYGHUR TURKS

Xinjiang has been under control of China since it was annexed in 1949. China claims that Uyghurs hold extremist views that are a threat to security.

At least 1 million Uyghurs have been interned since 2017 in more than 85 identified camps within Xinjiang-an autonomous region in Northwest China, according to Western reports. The Chinese government denied that the camps existed for a long time. However, after images of camp construction with watch towers and barbed wire fences emerged, the government acknowledged what they call “re-education centers” for Uyghurs.

Classes are taught in Mandarin. Chinese men are encouraged to marry Uyghur women. Uyghur women are being forcibly mass sterilized by China to suppress the population and separate Uyghur children from their families. It is a deliberate effort to “forcibly” assimilate the minority Uyghurs into the majority Han Chinese culture and “eradicate” the Uyghur culture.





As you all have witnessed, the period we live in is a period when hatred, prejudice and cruelty are at their peak. China's assimilation and oppression is getting worse day-by-day.

It is all happening in front of our eyes. Regardless of who they are, their religion or their language, a whole group of people are made to work as slaves, imprisoned in camps, tortured and raped.

This is not just a crime against Turks or Muslims, it is a crime against the entire humanity.

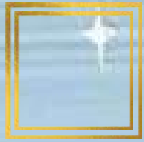

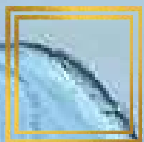

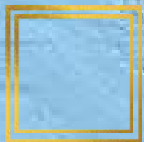

# *TO KILL A MOCKINGBIRD*

"Atticus told me to delete the adjectives and I'd have the facts." What an impressive quote!

This quote is from the book *To Kill a Mockingbird* by Harper Lee. This book is one of the books that impressed me a lot.

The Pulitzer Prize *To Kill a Mockingbird* tells the racism and inequality behind America through the eyes of a child, Scout Finch, which has gained a special place in the hearts of all literary fans since its publication in 1960. To explain the book a little simply, Jem and Scout are siblings living with their fathers in the USA.

Their mother died when they were little children, and the children were cared for by Calpurnia, their black home worker, and Atticus, their father. Scout, the little girl, tells the events from her point of view. I think that telling the events they experienced through the eyes of a child strengthens the quality of the book.



Harper Lee who is author of *To Kill a Mockingbird*, examines favor and evil at both individual and social levels, combining still current themes such as justice, freedom, equality, and discrimination, along with Scout's growth story, through his plain but striking language.

The author has another book that is *Go Set a Watchman*. *Go Set a Watchman*, which is a sequel to the book, was published in 2015, but it was actually the first book he wrote, and when his publisher told him to make the main character a child, he rewrote the book and brought out *To Kill a Mockingbird*. Although *To Kill a Mockingbird* is not as outstanding as the book, *Go Set a Watchman* is liked by lots of people. This book has 358 pages. There are English and Turkish versions in Turkey. You should read both in my opinion. If you want to get to know America a little better or if you want to read an impressive novel, this book is for you. You will thank me when you read it.

Additionally, he broke "19" world records in his figure skating carrier.

Furthermore, he became the first man single skater to complete the Super Slam. For those who don't know what Super Slam is, if you win all three major senior-level International Competitions (World Championship, Grand Prix Final and Four Continents Championship) you will be called "Grand Slam" or "Super Slam".

# SAVE

## WHAT IS SAVE RALPH?

Save Ralph is a stop motion mockumentary animated short film written and directed by Spencer Susser. The plot follows an interview with Ralph, a rabbit who details his life as he is used for animal testing and the damages it has caused to his body. Produced by Jeff Vespa, the 4-minute short film was released by Humane Society International on April 6, 2021, to critical acclaim.

Speaking with Humane Society International for a documentary on his rabbit life as he works every day as a "tester" for cosmetic products, Ralph tells the production crew how he is blind on one eye and is partially deaf. While preparing for work, Ralph explains with a sad tone how he does not necessarily care about his life, as he feels sacrificing his body to help humans is worth it. At a laboratory, Ralph's rabbit friends beg for the production crew to free them from their trials, before Ralph is injected with an unknown chemical into his only working eye. Now completely blind, Ralph says his final remarks; without animal testing, he would be out in a field "like a normal rabbit". As the video ends, Ralph gives a worried thumb-up towards the camera.

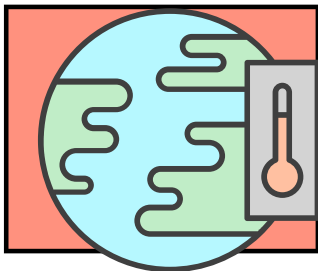
# OZONE LAYER IS IN DANGER

Earth's atmospheric ozone layer acts as a protective barrier between the Sun's harmful rays and the Earth's surface.

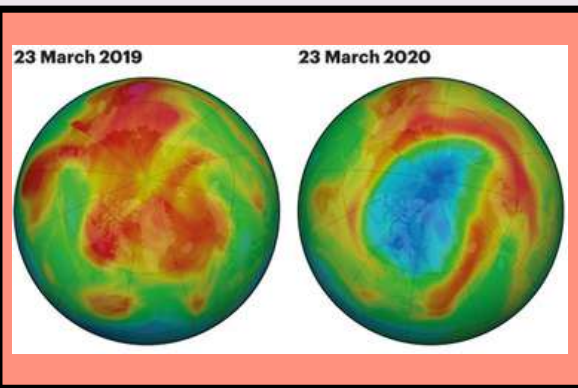
## “The largest ozone hole in the Arctic”

This week scientists from the European Space Agency said that this rare hole was the largest of its kind ever recorded over the planet's northern hemisphere. It covers an area about three times the size of Greenland, according to the Journal Nature.



## What did experts say about the hole?

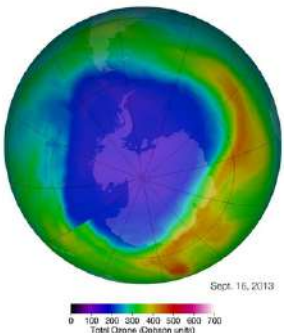
"From my point of view, this is the first time you can speak about a real ozone hole in the Arctic," Martin Dameris, an atmospheric scientist at the German Aerospace Center told Nature.



## Why was the ozone layer pierced?

- Cooler Production (fridge, air conditioning, etc.)
- Fire extinguishing
- Agricultural use
- Use as a Solvent (Metal cleaning, Electronics cleaning, etc.)

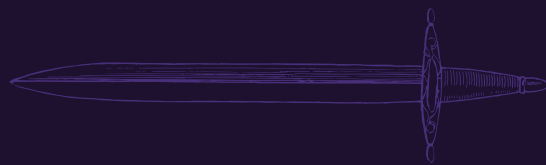
## What can we do to prevent the ozone layer from punching?



- We must regularly service refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners.
- Choose a vehicle that does not have a gas that damages the ozone layer.
- Do not use chemicals, insulating materials and packaging foams that damage the ozone layer unnecessarily.

# How to make an APPLE PIE

## Ingredients

- 1 recipe pastry for a double crust pie
- ½ cup unsalted butter
- 3 tablespoons flour
- ¼ cup water
- ½ cup white sugar
- ½ cup packed brown sugar
- 8 apples - peeled, cored and sliced

Preheat the oven to 220 degrees C. Melt the butter in a saucepan. Stir in flour to form a paste. Add water, white sugar and brown sugar, and bring to a boil. Reduce temperature and let simmer.

Place the bottom crust in your pan. Fill with apples, mounded slightly. Cover with a latticework crust. Gently pour the sugar and butter liquid over the crust. Pour slowly so that it does not run off.

Bake for 15 minutes in the preheated oven. Reduce the temperature to 175 degrees C. Continue baking for 35 to 45 minutes, until the apples are soft.

# The Finnish Education System

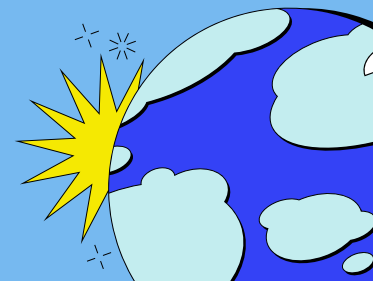


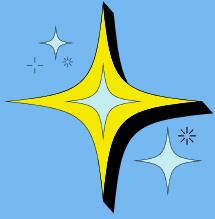
Kari Louhivuori has been teaching for 40 years now. For 32 years, he was the head of one of the best schools in Finland. Now he is as a kind of "ambassador of Finnish education" – the education which is considered one of the best in the world. This is confirmed by the high positions in the Programme for International Student Assessment (PISA) rankings. The test assesses the level of knowledge in mathematics, reading, and sciences.

Kari Louhivuori revealed the secret of all successful schools – they focus on their teachers, the educational process, and a comfortable environment.

There are no mandated standardized tests in Finland, apart from one exam at the end of students' senior year in high school. There are no rankings, no comparisons or competition between students, schools or regions

**1** Turkey is a redundant concept for the game. It is an indispensable curiosity for Finland.

**2** While children go to school and receive education with the fear of grades and violence, the main motivation in their country is curiosity and happiness.

**3** While break times are trying to be shortened even now, they have set a daily break limit of 75 minutes.

**4** While it is forbidden for students to speak and express themselves in our country, the most listened segment of Finland is students.

**5** While there are problems in families due to homework and heavy exams, happy children are raised here in Finland because there is no homework and exam stress.

And we are aware that clearing the remnants of past years in our system is not that easy. However, it is not difficult to raise a happy generation with small touches. How? We can improve the quality of our education by reducing homework, reducing lecture attachments, trying to teach information with curiosity rather than violence and fear, by hearing and valuing what students say, allowing them to play and live.

## *Attack on Titan*

It's been eight years since the anime adaptation of Hajime Isayama's *Attack on Titan* first aired and despite the countless side and main characters who have been brutally killed, and the world-shattering revelations we've experienced, it feels like the story is just getting started. This means there's no better time to give this show a try!

For those who haven't seen the show yet, *Attack on Titan* follows a group of teenagers living inside cities surrounded by three enormous walls that protect the last vestiges of humanity from gigantic humanoid "Titans" that devour people seemingly for no reason. One day, the outer wall is breached by a colossal Titan and thousands died following the attack, including the mother of Eren Yeager, our protagonist. The show then follows Eren as he vows to join the military so he can kill every single Titan he can find.

From a mainstream follower of anime, here are reasons why *AOT* is worth checking out. Warning: Death, violence and gore are common themes.



- Unexpected twists are plenty

The first viewing will provide one with the expected moments that are sure to elicit “oohs” and “aahs” from viewers. Watch out for all the historical detail about “humanity” that will be explained along the way. If you’ve already seen it once, watching the anime all over again will peel more details you thought you already knew but didn’t really. It’s a layer of stories worth revisiting time and again.

- The soundtrack is eclectic

Sure, epic moments within the storyline are great. But to have these moments accompanied by orchestra-heavy, classical-influenced and dubstep-sprinkled scoring just elevates the whole experience, pushing viewers past the mere musical comprehension and into the ethereal.

- The action scenes are intense

Yes, this article just mentioned AOT as an epic fantasy action drama. However, Wikipedia lists it under “Action,” “Dark Fantasy” and “Post-Apocalyptic.” Whatever the case, the action scenes rely on swift acrobatic movement and a lot of slashing. ## *Yakusaoku no Neverland –The Promised Neverland*

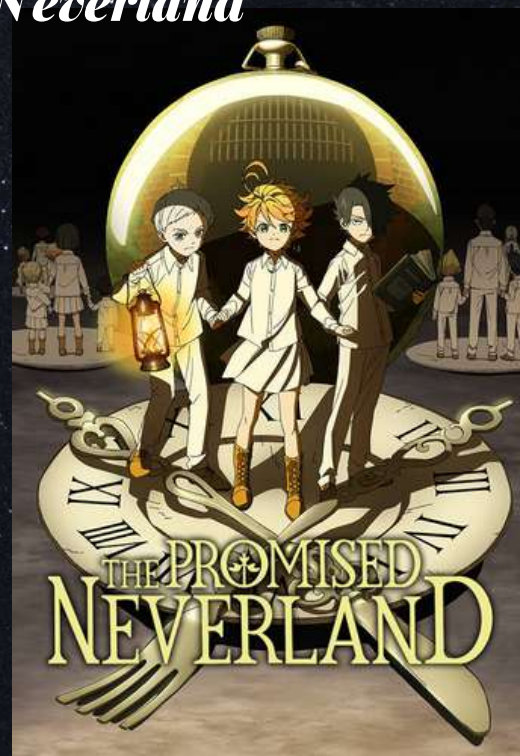

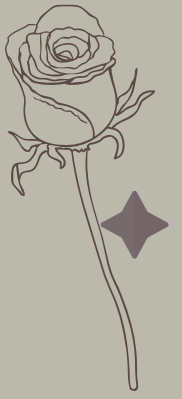
This movie is about a man who falls on an island one day, but still does not give up and gets rid of this island thanks to his punctuality.
